

# Reporting of Interstate Water Transfers under Schedule E and Supporting Protocols

## Annual Calendar

Due Date	Reporting details for Schedule E
30 June each year	<p>State Contracting Governments must in accordance with any protocol prepare and give to the Commission a report on measures taking in that State in the preceding year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) to manage any adverse environmental effects attributable to interstate transfers of entitlement or allocations into and out of that State</li> <li>b) to implement and monitor environmental assessment criteria and procedures for the use of water transferred into the State on land at its destination</li> </ul>
31 December each year	<p>Commission must in accordance with any protocol prepare and give to each State Contracting Government a report setting out the following information for the preceding year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) the total volume of transfers of entitlements and allocations into and out of each State</li> <li>b) the exchange rates applied to interstate transfers referred to in paragraph 17 (2) (a)</li> <li>c) any adjustments to the delivery of a State's entitlement made under clause 7</li> <li>d) any adjustment to the contribution of a State Contracting Government approved by the Ministerial Council under sub-clause 9 (2)</li> <li>e) any adjustment to the Cap on diversions for a designated river valley made under clause 8</li> </ul>

<b>Due Date</b>	<b>Reporting details for Schedule E Protocols</b>
Within 7 days after end of each month	Each licensing authority must send to the Commission a copy of its records relating to interstate transfers of entitlements and allocations.
Within 14 days after the end of each month	The Commission must provide a report on every discrepancy found in accordance with the processing protocol in relation to the states information. Report must go back to the States.
Within 30 days at the end of each quarter	<p>The Commission must prepare and give each contracting government and licensing authorities an interstate transfer report with respect to the preceding quarter.</p> <p>Report must cover:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) the number of interstate transfers of entitlements and allocations</li> <li>b) the volume of water represented by such transfers</li> <li>c) the number and type of discrepancies which have not been resolved under sub clause (5) of Step 8, and the name of the relevant licensing authority</li> <li>d) any other information, comment or recommendation which the Commission thinks appropriate</li> </ul>
